About Bill McKibben:

Bill McKibben is a renowned author, educator, and environmentalist. In 1989, he published [The End of Nature](#), the first book about climate change written for a general audience. He has since published more than a dozen books, and hundreds of essays and articles about global warming, alternative energy, and sustainable economies. In 2007, McKibben published [Deep Economy: the Wealth of Communities and the Durable Future](#), a

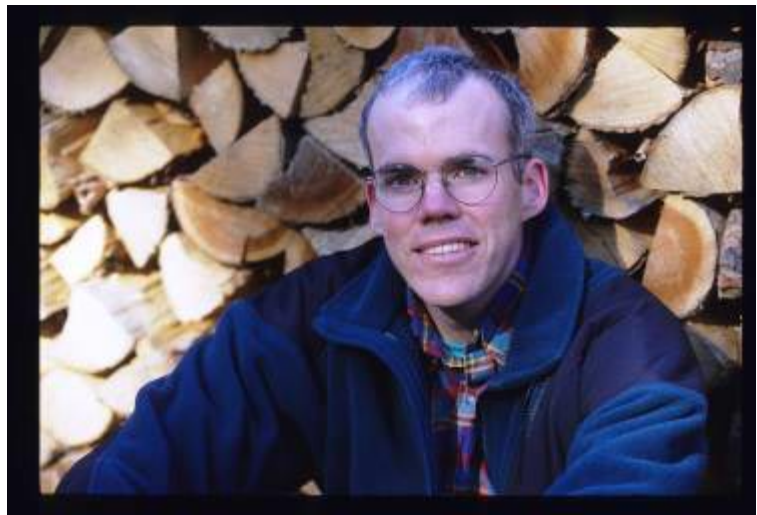

book that addresses shortcomings of the growth economy and envisions a transition to more local-scale enterprise. In late summer 2006, Bill helped lead a five-day walk across Vermont to demand action on global warming, and later founded stepitup2007.org to demand that Congress enact curbs on carbon emissions that would cut global warming pollution 80 percent by 2050. Based on his experience with Step It Up, McKibben published [Fight Global Warming Now](#), a guide to help people initiate environmental activism in their community. Bill is a frequent contributor to various magazines including *The New York Times*, *The Atlantic Monthly*, *Harper's*, *Orion Magazine*, *Mother Jones*, *The New York Review of Books*, *Granta*, *Rolling Stone*, and *Outside*.
