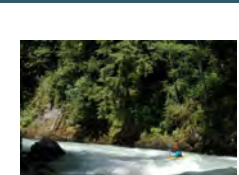
Alaska Wilderness League, Washington, DC **\$35,000**



Preserve the Reserve Campaign

To ensure that eight Special Areas in Alaska's National Petroleum Reserve with the highest wilderness and wildlife values are granted the strongest possible protection by the Obama Administration by the end of 2012.

North Cascades Wild and Scenic Rivers Campaign

To permanently protect more than 150 miles of rivers and tributaries in the North Cascades, and ensure that their related ecological, recreational, and cultural values are protected through federal designations under the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.

Campaign to Protect Maine's 100-mile Wilderness Region

To acquire and protect 30,000 acres of new conservation lands adjacent to both the Appalachian Trail and AMC's 66,500 acres of existing conservation lands in the 100-mile Wilderness region of Maine.

Western Arctic Campaign

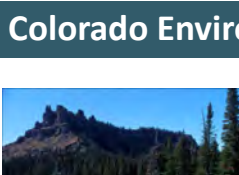

To secure strong protection for all or most of the 17-million-acre Peel River watershed with significant First Nations participation in long-term policy and management.

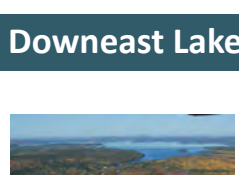

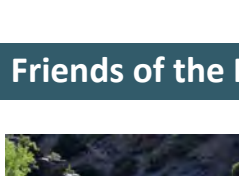
Downeast Lakes Land Trust, Grand Stream, ME **\$35,000**

To secure Wild and Scenic designations for nearly 380 miles of rivers in California.

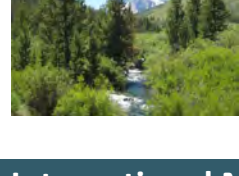

White River National Forest Campaign

To permanently protect high-quality lands in Colorado's White River National Forest through federal designations that are companions to Wilderness protections, and to use the protocol developed to create this legislation to protect additional acreage surrounding Wilderness areas throughout the country.

Wild Rogue Campaign

John Day Wilderness Campaign

To defeat the proposed Enbridge Northern Gateway oil pipeline and tanker proposal, keeping coastal British Columbia unspoiled.

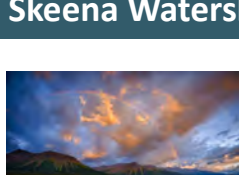
Skeena Watershed Conservation Coalition, Hazelton, BC **\$30,000**

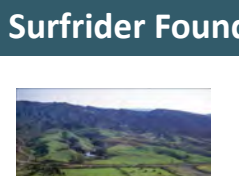

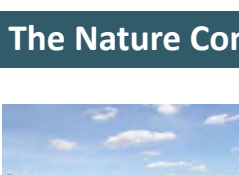
