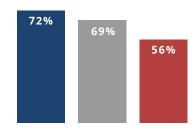
The environment matters. A political candidate's views on the environment play an important role in determining who we cast our vote for.

Voting habits of the outdoor

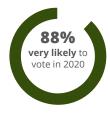
community: We are more likely to vote in 2020, but collectively we still vote less than we think we do.



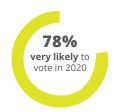
More likely to participate in 2020 than 2016
